Sanghamitra School Safety Club's monthly activity included raising awareness of CYBER SAFETY. The safety club members conducted a program for students of Class VI to X in the school auditorium.

The program started with Ms. Radhika Balamitra who gave an introduction to the usage of technology and its importance in everyday life. As it is very important to be safe in real life, it is equally important for all of us to be safe while online or using the Internet.

A video on safe practices was shown to students, where students were made aware of the dangers lurking on the internet and the need to be upstanders and not bystanders.

Ms Lavanya, Ms Swathi Balamithras shared a PowerPoint presentation where awareness was created on the different types of Cyberbullying and how to deal with them. Balamithras also spoke about the safe practices that students need to follow when they are online. They stressed the importance of using the internet under the guidance of elders, parents at home, and teacher's guidance at school.

Ms Swathi Balamithra and students of classes 6 to 8 performed two plays. The first play showed students on how addictions to computer games affect students. The second skit included recognizing the symptoms of students being bullied online and the need to seek help.
