It is time to commemorate the victory of good over evil. It is Dussehra and students of classes II, V and VI unfolded the Dussehra theme with an Assembly Presentation. The presentation included speeches, dances, and drama with students dressed in colourful costumes.

The program started with Divya teacher welcoming the audience and inviting class II students who shared the two important mythological stories of Dussehra.

The first story was about Ramayana where Rama defeated the ten-headed demon king Ravana. It was a story of truth prevailing over evil. and inviting class V and Vi students with a classical dance depicting the prominence of Dussehra. The second story was about Goddess Durga's victory over Mahishasura.

Students also shared the importance of overcoming the ten evils or the ten heads they are

Mada (Pride) Grina (Hate), Kama (Lust) Bhaye (Fear) Moha (Attachment), Krodh (Anger) Ahankar (Ego), Lobha (Greed)Jad data (Insensibility)and Irshya (Envy).

MA Durga also fought continuously for nine days to overcome the demon and on the tenth day, it is Durga Puja which marks the victory of Goddess Durga over the demon king Mahishasura. The different forms of Goddess Durga are

Day 1 of 9 is dedicated to Devi Shaila Putri – Yellow colour

Day 2 of 9 is dedicated to Devi Brahmacharini – Green colour

Day 3 of 9 is dedicated to Devi Chandra Ghanta – grey colour

Day 4 of 9 is dedicated to Devi Kushmanda – orange colour

Day 5 of 9 is dedicated to Devi Skanda Mata – white colour

Day 7 of 9 is dedicated to Devi Kalarathri – Blue colour

Day 8 of 9 is dedicated to Devi Mahagauri – Pink colour

Day 9 of 9 is dedicated to Devi Siddidhatri – Purple colour

It was time for class V and Vi students to present ‘Ai Giri Nandini ‘a classical dance. Children dressed in colourful costumes presented the classical dance gracefully and they mesmerised the audience.

It was time for the folk dance, a dapu dance that showcased the simple village folk. They work hard to give us food and enjoy the harvesting period with a simple dance.

The entire presentation enthralled the audience. Colourful and eye-catching costumes, and graceful and enchanting dances simply reflected the festive spirit
